A DYNAMIC STEAM MUSEUM AND CULTURAL ARTS CENTER

The Hammond Castle Museum is a dynamic STEAM museum blending historic significance as a house museum and lapidarium, showcasing stone and marble works. It offers tours, temporary exhibits, cultural events, and educational programming.

There are numerous ancient medieval and Renaissance architectural elements and artifacts within the Museum, including stone archways, sarcophagi, and grave markers.

On permanent display are exhibits relating to Hammond's many patents, including his work with radio control, television, and military technology, as well as the only surviving mural by artist Eric Pape.
